

# Canonbah Bridge

Named after the old township of Canonbah, that bordered the McLaughlin's farm. In the early 1900's the township was deserted and to this day all that remains is the old Canonbah Bridge.

## 2006 Canonbah Bridge Verdelho

### Vineyards:

100% Canonbah Bridge Vineyard, Western Plains, NSW.

### Winemaking:

Fermented in stainless steel tanks to enhance the floral elements of the wine. Partially aged in older Hungarian oak barrels for 3 months to enhance the spicier notes in the wine.

### Technical Details:

Varietals - 100% Verdelho

Bottling date: November 2006

pH: 3.57

Residual sugar: 5.5g/L

Alcohol: 13 % Vol

### Tasting Note:

This Verdelho is full bodied displaying rich spicy characters. The palate is dominated by lime citrus with a well balanced and lingering finish.

### Cellar potential:

Drink now with a cellar potential for up to 2 years.
