

Ram's Leap

The vineyard is planted on the virgin soils of a 2000 year old river bed, rich in alluvial deposits. Situated on the McLaughlin's 4th generation outback sheep station, the vines are maintained on a chemical free basis. Sheep play a crucial role in the vineyard for weed control.

2008 Rose

Infused with a spicy, peppery complexity that overlays the fresh strawberry and red cherry fruit.

Vineyards:

100% Shiraz - Canonbah Bridge vineyard, Western Plains, NSW.

Winemaking:

Made from free run Shiraz juice – with minimal skin contact. Stainless steel fermented. Bottled under stelvin closure to ensure the wine characters remain as intended.

Varietals – 100% Shiraz
Bottling date: September 2008
pH: 3.37
Residual sugar: 1.9g/L
Alcohol: 11.5%

Tasting Note:

Bursting with strawberries and cherries. The nose displays floral perfumatic characters. A balanced, crisp acidity gives the wine a lively clean finish.
